OSCE FORUM FOR SECURITY CO-OPERATION PROGRAMME

AIM: to enhance knowledge of the representatives of the OSCE participating States, point of contacts in capitals and the OSCE Executive Structures on the OSCE politico-military dimension and related topics, specifically on conventional arms control (CAC) and confidence and security-building measures (CSBMs).

STRUCTURE: Course on CAC and CSBMs (consisting of 4 introductory modules) and 4 introductory modules on other FSC topics, and 8 in-depth modules (see scheme below).

TARGET AUDIENCE: the introductory modules are intended for any delegates, national focal points in the capitals of the pS, verification centres and anyone associated with the agenda of the OSCE FSC who has professional interest in learning more about the topics covered in the Course. The in-depth modules, due to their more nuanced nature and breadth of information provided, is intended for any delegates, national focal points in the capitals of the pS, verification centres and anyone associated with the agenda of the pS, verification centres and anyone associated with the agenda of the OSCE FSC who has professional interest as well as previous experience or knowledge already gained on these topics.

LEARNING METHODS: Modules are delivered in the English language on the OSCE E-Learning platform. Learning elements are a blend of short videos, links to online videos, infographics, interactive elements and "traditional" text-based pages. The programme is completely self-paced, allowing participants to complete the modules at any time. Knowledge checks are performed through multiple choice questions dispersed throughout each module.

PARTICIPATION: Participation in the Programme is by invitation only. The Programme is currently under development and is planned to be finalized by 2023. Modules will be opened for participation twice a year (spring and autumn).
