## PROJECT BACKGROUND:

The project aims to assist the Kyrgyz Republic (KG) in reducing security and safety risks posed by stockpiles of small arms and light weapons (SALW) and conventional ammunition (CA) of the Ministry of Defense (MoD) of KG due to potential pilferage, sabotage and unplanned explosions, by improving SALW and CA life-management capacity of MoD in the KG.

The objective will be achieved through a review of existing legislation on SALW and CA and elaborating recommendations for improvement, developing a training system for life-cycle management of SALW and CA, conducting a feasibility study on the necessity to develop CA propellant chemical testing capability, and constructing three CA storage facilities in Ala-Buka, Kok-Dzhangak, and Batken region.

The project is part of the OSCE wider response to the implications of Afghanistan for the OSCE region launched in November 2021. The situation in Afghanistan – due to excessive and destabilizing accumulation and uncontrolled spread of SALW and CA – present an increased risk of illicit trafficking. Additionally, degraded SALW and CA physical infrastructure and poor stockpile management and security practices in Central Asia further increase security and safety risks due to potential pilferage, sabotage and unplanned explosions.
